1. Consent Agenda approved unanimously:

- a. Approved January 14, 2010 Meeting Minutes.
- b. Approved Reappointment of Jane Hemmer to the Chicopee Woods Area Park Commission.
- c. Approved Intergovernmental Agreement with Dawson County for Indigent Defense Services and authorize the Chairman to execute any related documents.
- d. Accepted 2,145 feet of right-of-way along Flowery Way into the County Maintenance System.
- e. Approved construction of the Mulberry Creek Tot Lot and Dog Park, as part of the Mulberry Creek Park Master Plan, per the concept plan.
- f. Approved construction of a left turn lane on J.M. Turk Road at the north driveway for Elah Valley Subdivision at an estimated construction cost of \$12,000.
- g. Approved the following bid:

2. Other Business:

- a. *Previously tabled* Held a first reading and public hearing to confirm the adoption of Chapter 4.10 entitled “Animal Services (2009 Revision)” of Title 4 of the Official Code of Hall County, Georgia as adopted on September 24, 2009, as well as to further amend said Chapter 4.10 by changing certain provisions relating to hazardous animals, shelter and sanitation and adoption of animals.
- b. Postponed a first reading and public hearing to amend the Official Code of Hall County, Georgia, Section 8.80.020 entitled “Unlawful Noises Designated” to prohibit loud noises from animals.

3. Public Hearings to consider applications to amend the Zoning Maps of Hall County:

- a. Held a second reading and public hearing and unanimously approved the name change of Holiday Road/Friendship Road (a.k.a. SR 347) to “Lanier Islands Parkway” from I-985 west to its terminus at Lake Lanier.

4. Consider other business presented by members of the Commission

- a. Unanimously adopted the Association County Commissioners of Georgia’s current draft Code of Ethics, to be updated with the final version and the recommendations of the Citizen Committee at a future date.

- b. Unanimously appointed a Citizen Committee to review the Commission's Code of Ethics: Douglas Aiken, Scott Gibbs and Tommy Sandoval.
- c. Unanimously voted that the Citizen Committee will be subject to Open Meetings Law, with all meetings advertised so the public can participate.
- d. Directed Engineering staff to work with the Quiet Place in the Woods Neighborhood Association to install an emergency access to the neighborhood.
