1. Consent Agenda approved unanimously:

- a. Approved January 22, 2010 Meeting Minutes.
- b. Approved January 28, 2010 Meeting Minutes.
- c. Approved Appointment of Mary Ann Hurst to the Parks & Leisure Services Board.
- d. Approved Appointment of Pastor Jeff Benefield to the Tax Assessors' Board.
- e. Approved Hall County Treatment Services Application to the U.S. Department of Justice for a FY 2010 Adult Drug Court Discretionary Grant Program.
- f. Approved the City of Oakwood's application on behalf of Lanier Technical College for a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG).
- g. Approved extension of \$2,000 Irrevocable Letter of Credit for Common Area Sidewalks in Highland Gates Subdivision.
- h. Approved construction of a sidewalk from Lanier Village Estates to the Kroger Shopping Center in an amount not to exceed \$35,000.
- i. Approved submission of a letter to Representative Doug Collins requesting local legislation to change the Hall County Grand Jury's terms.
- j. Approved objection to Buford's proposed annexation located at 6249 Rock Port Drive and that the County Attorney and the County Planning Director be authorized to take all administrative and/or judicial actions necessary to pursue the County's objections to said annexation.

2. Other Business:

- a. North Hall Park/Library.
 1. Motion to table the item for two weeks. Failed 2-3 (Tom Oliver, Bobby Banks, Billy Powell opposed).
 2. County Administrator Charley Nix addressed the Commission, along with GIS Manager Mark Lane, Architect Jeff Crocker, and Financial Services Director Michaela Thompson, with information about the possible combination of the North Hall Park and the North Hall Library.
 3. Unanimously approved a second motion to table the item until the Feb. 25 meeting.
- b. Held a second reading and public hearing to confirm the adoption of Chapter 4.10 entitled "Animal Services (2009 Revision)" of Title 4 of the Official Code of Hall County, as well as to further amend said Chapter 4.10 by changing certain provisions relating to hazardous animals, shelter and sanitation and adoption of animals. Approved 5-0.

- c. Presentation by the Lake Lanier Convention and Visitors Bureau regarding the American Bass Anglers Tournament.
- d. Reading and public hearing to amend section 2.50.140 of Chapter 2.50 "Recreation and Parks" of Title 2 of the Official Code of Hall County, deleting section 2.50.140 entitled "Alcoholic Beverages prohibited generally" in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof a new section 2.50.140 with the same name for the purpose of prohibiting alcoholic beverages in a recreation facility, except as may be specifically authorized pursuant to Chapters 5.10, 5.30 and 5.60 of Title 5 of this code. Approved 3-2 (Bobby Banks and Steve Gailey opposed).
- e. Unanimously denied a resolution to amend the Sewer and Sewage Disposal Fee Schedule for the residents of the Mulberry Creek/Spout Springs sewer area by updating the method by which the fee is determined. Staff was instructed to pursue other alternatives.
