## CRIME PREVENTION ALERT

DATE: November 30, 2010 SUBJECT: Suspicious Activity

Hall County Sheriff's Investigators are requesting assistance in identifying a vehicle and an individual involved in suspicious activity in the South Hall area.

The incident involved an individual who was seen walking around a residence taking photographs of the house. When approached by the home's occupant, the subject stated that he was "with the bank," presumably as an appraiser or in some similar capacity, but presented no identification or business card. The home's occupant however, knew nothing of this person or of any reason why the bank would send someone to the premises taking photos. The individual departed the scene without incident.

## **SUBJECT DESCRIPTION:**

White male in his early to mid 60's, approximately 5' 8", medium build, short gray hair, green eyes, wearing wire-rim glasses.

## **VEHICLE DESCRIPTION:**

Approximately late 90's to early 2000's Toyota Camry or similar passenger car, 4-door, silver in color, no window tint. It was reported to have a Hall County tag, but the number is not known.

We have had very similar incidents reported in different locations recently, but none have been directly tied to burglaries or thefts as of yet. Their purpose may be entirely legitimate, but there are enough suspicious circumstances surrounding the incidents that Investigators would like to make positive identification of the person(s) involved and attempt to verify their stories. If you are approached by someone that says they are acting in this capacity, ask them for identification and a business card.

As always, if you see behavior such as this or any suspicious activity that would give someone a semilegitimate reason to be in a neighborhood while allowing them to scout for burglary opportunities, call dispatch at 770-536-8812 or 9-1-1 so a Deputy can respond and investigate.
