Sheriff's Office Renews Call for Assistance in Murder Case

The Hall County Sheriff's Office is renewing its request for information from the public in the David Sanchez homicide investigation. Mr. Sanchez, a businessman well known in the local Latino community, was shot on April 12, 2012 outside of the Victory Foods poultry plant in Gainesville and later succumbed to his injuries.

Witnesses have provided investigators with information and descriptions of three subjects involved in the crime. All three are described as Hispanic males between the ages of 18 – 30, dressed similar to the employees working at the poultry plant, wearing blue jeans, hair nets, and hooded sweatshirts, possibly in an attempt to blend in with the workers.

Witnesses also provided a description of a vehicle believed to be involved: a 1994 – 1998 Chevrolet Cavalier, green in color, tag number unknown.

A \$10,000 reward fund has been established in the local community for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the person(s) responsible for Mr. Sanchez's murder.
