

Reward Offered in Truelove Case

The Hall County Sheriff's Office and the Georgia Bureau of Investigation are announcing that Governor Nathan Deal has signed an executive order authorizing a \$1,000 reward for the identification, arrest, and conviction of the person or persons responsible for the death of Hannah Truelove.

Ms. Truelove, a Gainesville High School student, was found murdered behind Lake Lanier Club Apartments, where she lived with her mother, on August 24, 2012. Her body was discovered in a heavily wooded area between the apartment complex and Lake Lanier by a resident. She had been stabbed multiple times.

In addition to any information available, investigators are still specifically looking for a late 1990's to early 2000's four-door passenger car (possibly a Chevrolet or Dodge product) that may have been in the area of Lake Lanier Club Apartments during the evening hours of August 23, 2012. The car is light silver in color, with substantial front end damage and a driver's door that is either white or a lighter shade of silver. Investigators believe the occupants of the vehicle may have important information that will aid the investigation.
