

Chestatee Middle School Student Charged with Terroristic Threats

On February 6th, Hall County Sheriff's Investigators arrested a 14 year-old male student for making threats of a shooting.

Investigators and school officials were made aware of the situation after classmates overheard the student on February 4th making comments about "shooting up the school." The students notified their parents later that evening, and the parents brought it to the attention of officials.

No specific threat information, such as plans, dates/times, or people targeted were involved, and no weapons or destructive devices were located at the school or in the possession of the suspect

The student was arrested and booked into the Gainesville Regional Youth Detention Center, charged with one count of terroristic threats.

This case remains under investigation by the Hall County Sheriff's Office, Criminal Investigations Division.
