

Two Arrested and a Third Person Wanted for Burglary

On October 9, 2012 just after midnight, Sheriff's Deputies and investigators responded to the area of Mount Vernon Road and Old Dahlonega Highway, Clermont, in reference to a possible burglary in progress. Deputies arrived and detained 22 year-old Jonathan Burnett and 25 year-old Casey Walls, both of Murrayville, until investigators arrived.

Investigators interviewed the subjects and learned that they had burglarized a vacant residence in the 6000 block of Old Dahlonega Highway. Numerous small items such as silverware, phones, costume jewelry, and other property was taken from that residence and discovered in the subjects' vehicle. Investigators arrested and charged Burnett and Walls with one count each of 1st degree burglary and secured an arrest warrant for Randy Lee Berry, who fled prior to the Deputies' arrival and is still being sought. Burnett and Walls are both currently free on bond.

All of the recovered property, valued at over \$200, was identified and returned to the rightful owner.

The incident remains under investigation by the Hall County Sheriff's Office, Criminal Investigations Division.
