

Sheriff's Office Investigating Horse Shooting

The Hall County Sheriff's Office is investigating a horse shooting that took place late last week.

On March 29, 2012, Sheriff's Deputies responded to the 6700 block of West County Line Road, Lula, regarding a report of two horses being shot. Upon arrival, Deputies learned that a family member of the horse owner had discovered one of the animals lying dead in the pasture. Closer inspection revealed multiple gunshot wounds to the animal, and a check of the remainder of the victim's horses revealed that one more had been also been shot but survived.
