

## **Seven Arrested in Cocaine Deal**

January 6, 2012

On January 5, 2012, Agents from the Gainesville-Hall County Multi-Agency Narcotics Squad, Gang Task Force, and FBI, along with Deputies and Officers from the Hall County Sheriff's Office and Gainesville Police Department Uniformed Patrol Divisions, arrested seven individuals during the course of an undercover drug investigation.

The investigation began earlier during the same week and came to a close as the aforementioned suspects arrived at a predetermined location with a quantity of US currency, which was intended to be used to purchase several kilograms of cocaine.

Agents seized over \$83,000 during the investigation.

All seven suspects were arrested without incident and subsequently booked in at the Hall County Jail, charged as follows:
