Please pass the word:

Dispatch has received several calls regarding subjects seeming suspicious, specifically going to residences and stating that they are working for Atlanta Gas Light Company and that they are servicing and repainting gas meters. What appears unusual about these folks is that they are not in uniform and they are driving privately owned vehicles.

I spoke with a representative of AGL and verified that they are legitimate contractors. They are currently working the North Hall area, but they are based out of the Hall County Service Center and could be working anywhere. The individuals should have clearly visible identification badges issued by AGL that have "contractor" with their names on it, and they may be wearing a reflective safety vest of some sort.

Receiving these types of calls is excellent. Reporting what doesn't seem right is exactly what we want citizens to do. As I've stated many times, we would much prefer to respond to a call to check out what seems suspicious, only to find out that it's legitimate, as opposed to not getting a call until someone has been victimized.
