SUBJECT: Vacation Home Checks

In our on-going efforts to combat property crimes, the Hall County Sheriff's Office is pleased to announce the implementation of our Vacation Home Check program. While this is not necessarily a new service, we have changed the way we are conducting and administering it, so that hopefully it will become accessible to more people and more widely utilized.

Here's how it works:

If you're going to be away from home for more than one night and wish to have your residence checked by our patrol division to deter criminal activity and check for signs of such activity, fill out the request form on our website at the following link:

Please fill out the form completely, including date departing & returning, emergency contact number, and any special notes (like if you're going to have someone stopping by to pick up mail and look after the place, or if you have a *really* big dog in the back yard that doesn't like Deputies...). Try to give us about three to five days notice prior to the requested start date.

Upon your return, you'll receive a letter from us letting you know the dates & times that the house was checked, and if anything unusual was noted.

We hope that our citizens will not only find this service useful, but that it will also be another effective crime prevention tool.
