

SERVSAFE FOOD PROTECTION MANAGER CERTIFICATION COURSE SCHEDULE 2020

Hall County Environmental Health Department is offering the **SERVSAFE Food Protection Manager Certification Course** and examination on the following dates:

This course is one of four professional certification courses recognized by the **Georgia Department of Public Health, Rules and Regulations, Chapter 511-6-1 Food Service** to fulfill the Certified Food Safety Manager requirement. Certification is valid for five years.

If you have taken the course in the past or have taken the course online and would like the option to take the exam only without attending the course, you may contact the Hall County Environmental Health Department to schedule either an online examination and/or paper examination and to request a required exam proctor.
