VISITATION RULES

ITEMS NOT PERMITTED IN THE VISITATION AREA:

1. Cell Phones, Pagers, Wallets, Billfolds and purses are not permitted in the building and must be secured in your vehicle.
2. Currency is only permitted for use in the drink and snack machines. Single dollar bills (\$1.00) and coins are permitted up to twenty (\$20.00).
3. Pictures or papers of any kind are not permitted.
4. Supplies for small children and infants are permitted. These items will be searched and must be left at the sign in desk until needed. Inmates are not permitted to change diapers.

ATTIRE:

1. Inappropriate clothing will be cause to refuse admittance and / or termination of visitation.
2. Provocative, revealing, sheer or see-through materials are not acceptable attire.
3. Sleeveless garments, tanks and shirts that expose the mid-rift are not permitted.
4. Appropriate undergarments must be worn.
5. Skirts and dresses may be worn but must come to the middle of the back of the knee.
6. Shorts are not considered appropriate attire except for visitors who are ten (10) years of age or younger.
7. Plain white tee shirts and sweaters are not permitted.
8. Sunglasses, hats or any type of head covering will not be permitted. The only exceptions are for religious articles.
9. Pullover sweaters are permitted in the visitation area but cannot be removed after entering the visitation area.
10. Coats and jackets are not permitted in the visitation area. A coat rack is available just inside the visitation entryway where your coats may be stored during the visitation period.

VISITOR CHECK-IN:

1. All visitors and their vehicles are subject to search.
2. All vehicles must be secured before entering the visitation area.
3. Only individuals who are listed on the inmate's approved visitors list will be admitted.
4. Children and pets must not be left unattended in vehicles for any reason.
5. Visitors aged sixteen (16) years and older must provide a valid Picture ID (State ID Card or Driver's License).
6. Visitors are required to place all personal items (including the contents of pockets) on the desk at check-in.
7. Physical contact is not permitted except for the beginning and conclusion of a visit.
8. Children must be supervised at all times. Disruptive behavior must be addressed by the visitor who is the parent / guardian. Excessive disruptions may be cause to terminate a visit.
