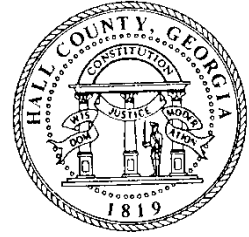

Steps to Appeal to Superior Court:

1. Within thirty (30) days of receiving your final decision from the Board of Equalization, you must provide in writing to the **Hall County Board of Tax Assessors'** your intention to appeal the final decision to Superior Court.
 - a. Please note that the thirty (30) days is from the time you received by hand and/or USPS Postmark date of your final decision notification.
2. The Board of Tax Assessors shall notify you of a settlement conference within 45 days of receipt of the appeal. The settlement conference shall be held no later than thirty (30) days from the receipt of this notice.
 - a. This notice will also include more detailed information pertaining to the Appeal Process to Superior Court.
3. Should no agreement be reached at the settlement conference, the Board of Tax Assessors shall provide written notification to continue the process to Superior Court.
 - a. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, the filing fee is \$25.00 and shall be made payable to the Hall County Clerk's Office in the form of cash, money order, or attorney's check.
 - b. Within (20) days of the settlement conference date, you will need to provide proof of payment to the Hall County Clerk of Superior Court in the amount of \$25.00 to the Tax Assessors' Office.
