OFFICIAL GENERAL MUNICIPAL AND SPECIAL ELECTION BALLOT OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA NOVEMBER 5, 2019

To vote, blacken the Oval (●) next to the candidate of your choice. To vote for a person whose name is not on the ballot, manually WRITE his or her name in the write-in section and blacken the Oval (●) next to the write-in section. If you desire to vote YES or NO for a PROPOSED QUESTION, blacken the corresponding Oval (●). Use only blue or black pen or pencil.

Do not vote for more candidates than the number allowed for each specific office. Do not cross out or erase. If you erase or make other marks on the ballot or tear the ballot, your vote may not count.

If you change your mind or make a mistake, you may return the ballot by writing "Spoiled" across the face of the ballot and return envelope. You may then mail the spoiled ballot back to your county board of registrars, and you will be issued another official absentee ballot. Alternatively, you may surrender the ballot to the poll manager of an early voting site within your county or the precinct to which you are assigned. You will then be permitted to vote a regular ballot.

"I understand that the offer or acceptance of money or any other object of value to vote for any particular candidate, list of candidates, issue, or list of issues included in this election constitutes an act of voter fraud and is a felony under Georgia law." [OCGA 21-2-285(h) and 21-2-383(a)]

**SPECIAL ELECTION**

**Hall County SPLOST**  
(Vote for One)

Shall a special one percent (1%) sales and use tax be imposed in Hall County for a period of time not to exceed twenty-four (24) calendar quarters (six years) and for the raising of an estimated amount of Two Hundred Sixteen Million Nine Hundred Sixty Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$216,960,000) for the following purposes: Level Two County-Wide Projects of Hall County: (1) acquisition, construction and equipping of trails and associated greenspace, (2) construction of improvements on and to the Hall County Government Center campus and building, (3) construction of a parking deck adjacent to the main branch of the Hall County Library, (4) construction of improvements to the Hall County landfill, (5) acquiring ambulances, (6) expansion and improvements to the Hall County Fire Training Center, (7) acquisition, construction and equipping of an East Hall branch of the Hall County Library, (8) renovations and construction of improvements to the Hall County Courthouse complex building and campus, (9) renovations and construction of improvements to the Elachee Nature Center building for Chicopee Woods Area Park Commission, (10) construction of improvements to the Community Service Center campus, and (11) paying any general obligation debt incurred for Level Two Projects and issued in conjunction with such tax; Hall County Projects: (1) improving and constructing roads, streets, bridges, sidewalks and related improvements, (2) acquiring, constructing and equipping water and sewer facilities, (3) constructing, renovating and/or equipping fire protection facilities, and acquiring fire apparatus and equipment, (4) acquiring, constructing and installing parks and leisure facilities and equipment, (5) constructing, remodeling, acquiring and/or equipping public safety facilities, including patrol cars, (6) making County building renovations and improvements, (7) acquisition, installation and equipping of technology infrastructure and enhancements at Hall County facilities, and (8) paying any general obligation debt incurred for Hall County Projects and issued in conjunction with such tax; Town of Braselton Projects: (1) improving and constructing roads, streets, bridges, sidewalks and related improvements, and (2) acquiring, constructing, installing and improving parks and leisure facilities; City of Buford Projects: improving and constructing roads, streets, bridges, sidewalks and related improvements; City of Clermont Projects: (1) improving and constructing roads, streets, bridges, sidewalks and related improvements, and (2) acquiring, constructing, installing and improving parks and leisure facilities and equipment; City of Flowery Branch Projects: (1) improving and constructing roads, streets, bridges, sidewalks and related improvements, (2) acquiring, constructing, installing and improving parks and leisure facilities, land and equipment, (3) acquisition of public safety vehicles and equipment, and (4) acquiring, constructing, installing and improving of public works facilities and equipment; City of Gainesville Projects: (1) improving and constructing roads, streets, bridges, sidewalks and related improvements, (2) acquiring, constructing, installing and improving parks and recreation facilities and equipment, (3) acquisition, and improvement of public safety facilities and equipment, and (4) construction of a downtown parking deck; City of Gillsville Projects: (1) improving and constructing roads, streets, bridges, sidewalks and related improvements, (2) acquiring, constructing, installing and improving parks and leisure facilities, vehicles and equipment, and (3) renovation, improvement, construction and installation of downtown infrastructure; City of Lula: (1) improving and constructing roads, streets, bridges, sidewalks and related improvements, (2) acquiring, constructing and installing water and sewer facilities, vehicles, and equipment, and (3) acquiring, constructing, installing and improving parks and leisure facilities, vehicles and equipment; City of Oakwood Projects: (1) improving and constructing roads, streets, bridges, sidewalks and related improvements, (2) acquiring, constructing and installing water and sewer facilities, and (3) acquisition of public safety vehicles and equipment; and City of Rest Haven Projects: improving and constructing roads, streets, bridges, sidewalks and related improvements.

If imposition of the tax is approved by the voters, such vote shall also constitute approval of the issuance of general obligation debt of Hall County in the principal amount of Forty Million and 00/100 Dollars (\$40,000,000) for the purpose of paying a portion of the costs of the projects described in items (2) and (6) of the Level Two Projects above and the projects described in items (1), (2) and (3) of the Hall County Projects above, and for the purpose of payment of the expenses incident to issuance of the debt.
