

PROVISIONAL

- These 126 ballots have been researched and found as eligible to be accepted. There are no outstanding requirements.

Staff recommends the Board accept these 126 ballots.

- These 63 ballots have been researched and found ineligible to be accepted for the following reasons:
 - 40 rejected for “out of county”
 - 6 cancelled for “inactivity”
 - 2 absentee by mail ballots that were already accepted
 - 13 “not registered”
 - 2 “canceled felons”

Staff recommends the Board reject these 63 ballots.

CHALLENGED PROVISIONAL-NCOA

The final ballots are from voters whose name appeared on the challenged lists that were presented to the Elections office for reason of National Change of Address. These challenges were denied by the Board on December 23rd. Staff researched these voters as well to ensure they were not otherwise ineligible.

- These 109 ballots have been researched and found to be eligible to be accepted.

Staff recommends the Board accept these 109 ballots.

These 2 ballots were also included on the challenged list.

- Staffs research revealed one voter is registered in another county and is not an eligible voter in Hall County.

Staff recommends the Board reject this ballot.

- The other voter voted a provisional, came to the meeting on December 23 when the challenges were denied, returned and voted on the machine.

Staff recommends the Board reject this ballot.
